



Script: Lining Up Three-peat

Teacher: Class!

Students: Yes!

Teacher: You have done a great job so far...let's see if you can handle the next step! Give me an, "Oh, yeah!"

Students: Oh, yeah!

Teacher: Hands and Eyes! (Fold hands together.)

Students: Hands and eyes! (The students quickly fold their hands and stare intently at the teacher.)

Teacher: When we stand in line as a class, I want you standing directly behind the person in front of you, facing forward and with your hands to your side. Once we enter the hallway, our Pirate Voices are quiet. Teach your neighbor our expectations when we're in line. (Clap twice.) Teach!

Students: (Clap twice.) Okay!

Teacher: Great! I'm now going to show you how I want you to line up when it's time to leave our classroom. I will say, "Lines!" You will give me a 3-peat and say, "Lines, lines, lines" loudly while standing up, scooting your chair under your desk and getting in line. (Show the students exactly where you want them to line up.) Once you're in line, snap your fingers three times to show me you're ready to leave. (Clap twice.) Teach!

Students: (Clap twice.) Okay! (Students teach each other what the teacher just said.)

Teacher: Oh, class!

Students: Oh, yes!

Teacher: Let's practice lining up. Remember, I will say, "Lines!" Then you will give me a 3-peat and say, "Lines, lines, lines." When you are in line I want you to snap your fingers three times to show me you are ready. Lines! (Stand by the Scoreboard.)

Students: Lines, lines, lines! (Students get in line; many will snap their fingers.)

Teacher: (Mark a Frowny on the Scoreboard.) That wasn't too bad for the first time, but I want you to be a bit quicker. (Have students return to their seats.) I'm going to count to 20. If everyone is in line correctly, I will give the class a Smiley. Remember to say, "Lines, lines, lines" and snap your fingers three times when you're ready. Lines!

Students: Lines, lines, lines! (Students quickly line up and snap their fingers three times.)

- Continue practicing, awarding a Smiley or Frowny as needed – not scooting chairs in, talking, not facing forward, hands not kept to self, etc.
- Create a Class Goal for lining up.
- Practice this procedure BEFORE you have to line up and go somewhere!
