- 3 be written as a complete sentence
- 4 start with a capital letter and end with correct punctuation

Feedback Example #1

Question: What is the weather like during the summer where you live?

First response:

chocolate



Your answer is not correct. Please try again.

Feedback Example #2

Question: What is the weather like during the summer where you live?

First response:

The weather is hot where I live.




Add details from the text to support your answer.

Feedback Example #3

Question: What is the weather like during the summer where you live?

First response:

Hot.



Your answer must be a complete sentence.

Feedback Example #4

Question: What is the weather like during the summer where you live?

the weather is hot where I live
temperatures reach 90 degrees

Possible Scores

Question: What is the weather like during the summer where you live?

1	The weather is hot where I live. Temperatures reach 90 degrees during the summer.
0.75	the weather is hot where I live temperatures reach 90 degrees
0.50	the weather is hot where I live
0.25	hot
0	chocolate
